Although open to the public, the Hearing Tribunal can close a portion or all of the Hearing at any time.

### Hearing Guidelines

- A Hearing is open to observers. The Hearing Tribunal can close a portion of all or any parts of the Hearing at any time. If any part of a Hearing is closed, observers will be required to exit the Hearing.
- The Hearing Tribunal can ask that an observer leave the Hearing room if the observer is disruptive or disrespectful of the Hearing process.
- There will be times that observers will be required to leave the Hearing room such as during lunch periods and deliberations by the Hearing Tribunal.
- Observers are not permitted to enter and exit the Hearing unless it is a scheduled break. If an observer leaves the Hearing during a time that is not a scheduled break, they will not be permitted to re-enter until after a scheduled break.
- No cell phones, cameras, or recording devices are permitted in the Hearing room.
- Observers will not be permitted to speak or provide written comments to the Hearing Tribunal or make any comments about any portion of the proceedings.
- Observers must remain quiet and calm throughout the Hearing.
- Observers cannot bring food and drink into the Hearing.
